
Parent Interview: Abbreviated Format

Volition

- Tell me about the types of things your child enjoys/enjoys doing.
- How do you know when your child is interested in an activity, toy/object, or person?
- Tell me about the types of choices your child makes during his/her day.
- What are some things that you think your child feels he/she does well or that he/she is proud of doing?
- What does your child do when things become difficult?

Habitation

- Describe your child's typical weekday and weekend routine at home/school/in the community.
- How does your child respond when it is time to stop one activity and move on to another activity/location?
- What roles does your child have right now and what things does your child do in that role (e.g., friend, family member, student)?

Skills: Communication & Interaction, Process, and Motor Skills

- How does your child let you and others know what he/she wants, how he/she feels, and/or convey his/her ideas (e.g., non-verbal communication, simple sentences, one word answers)?
- How does your child get along with/cooperate with others?
- What does your child do when he/she hears, sees, or notices different things in his/her surroundings, like people and objects (e.g., a telephone ringing, a familiar street sign, a fork)?
