I'm an OT working in an LD team in Birmingham. All senior OT staff are AMPs trained and the past 2 years we have been gradually introducing a variety of MOHO tools. The most successful are the MOHOST, VQ and OSA or an adapted OSA although we do use the OCAIRS and WRI but often not standardised. MOHO has really helped us to market and package our service and the tools have helped to give a sense of identity with the team. Hope this helps,
