MOHO is a set of concepts that can be applied to the practice of OT with any group of clients of any age. Check out the 4th edition of the MOHO text- each chapter includes pediatric examples. Also, cruise previous list serv posting for discussions related to MOHO and peds at

Finally, there are 5 pediatric specific MOHO assessments, and other MOHO assessments have also been used with children and youth, so there are many tools that help you apply MOHO in practice (COSA, SCOPE- to be released July 08- PIPs, SSI, PVQ, OTPAL, ACIS, Role Checklist, Interest Checklist, etc)
